### **III. INTRODUCTION**

The Maharashtra State Co-Operative Bank Ltd., at Mumbai in the State of Maharashtra (MSCB), issued a demand notice dated 03/10/2006 under Section 13 (2) of the Securitisation and Reconstruction of Financial Assets & Enforcement of Security Interest Act, 2002 (hereinafter referred to as “the SARFAESI Act”) calling upon **JAIKISAN SAHAKARI SAKHAR KARKHANA MARYADIT.**, a Co-operative based unit situated at VILLAGE - BODEGAON, TAL: DARWA, DIST: YAVATMAL, MAHARASHTRA, to repay within 60 days from the date of said notice, the amount mentioned therein being Rs.8976.15 Lakh (Rupees Eighty Nine Crore Seventy Six Lakh Fifteen Thousand only) including interest upto 31/08/2006 and other expenses and costs thereon at contractual rates upon the footing of compound interest until payment/ realisation.
